**GENERAL:** By entering the event all acknowledge and agree that they shall comply with the WTT rules, regulations, policies and additional requirements and procedures as issued by WTT.

**Entry to Host Country:** All participants are responsible for adhering to the border entry requirements – [Link to local government regulations](#).

**EVENT ENTRY DETAILS, TRAVEL/INSURANCE & TROPHY PRESENTATIONS**

**HOSPITALITY:** The EO reserves the right to move participants from the Official Hospitality Packages to the Accreditation option, in case the Member Association doesn't provide accommodation/travel details prior to the respective deadlines. First comes first serves policy is applied in case one of the Official Hospitality Options is fully booked. In case needed, the EO reserves the right to accommodate the participants at another hotel(s) (same level or higher level; same accommodation rates included on this prospectus).

**TRAVEL:** Player's participation at the Event is not confirmed prior to the entry deadline. We strongly recommend to not book flight tickets (or book refundable/flexible tickets) prior to getting the participation confirmation email from the WTT Event Supervisor. Transfers between airport/train to the hotel are provided only on the check-in and check-out dates.

**INSURANCE:** By entering the event, each Member Association must ensure that all the participants have medical, travel and other appropriate insurance.

**CHANGES:** Changes between subevents are not permitted after the entry deadline.

**PARTICIPANTS:** All participants for the Event (including coaches, ACC, Medical, Delegates) must be entered through the WTT OES. Accreditations and visa invitation letters are not provided to individuals not entered in the OES.

**TROPHY PRESENTATION:** Champions and finalists must attend the trophy presentations.

**NEW PLAYERS REGISTRATION:** The registration of new players, who never participated in a WTT/ITTF Event, and respective participation forms must be submitted not less than seven (7) days prior to the entry deadline. Player Registration Guide is available [here](#)

**ENTRY RESTRICTIONS & CANCELLATION PENALTIES**

**Cancelation penalty fees**

- Those who cancel the participation before 24 MAY 2026 20:00 SGT (UTC+8:00) will be required to pay **150 US\$ per person**.
- Those who cancel the participation after 24 MAY 2026 20:00 SGT (UTC+8:00) will be required to pay **150 US\$ + 1 night in Single room per person**.
- Those who cancel the participation after 31 MAY 2026 23:59 (local time) or no show will be required to pay **Full board hospitality**.

Cancellations after the entry deadline are subject to cancelation penalty fees (applicable to players and non-players). Players in WL are not required to pay cancelation penalty fees.

Only in case of a cancelation, when the next reserve player who confirms participation is from same Member Association, a cancelation penalty fee of USD 200 is applied provided that the confirmed player reserves the same room nights as the player cancelled.

Payments must be done prior the event start by bank transfer or directly upon arrival in cash.

**Host Wildcards**

- Singles: 2 players per subevent
- Doubles: 2 players per subevent
- Mixed Doubles: 4 players per subevent

**Player Entry Restriction**

- 2 singles subevents per player
- 1 doubles subevent per player
- 1 mixed doubles subevent per player
- Players are entitled to play doubles and mixed doubles in the same age category they are confirmed in Singles.

**National Entry Restriction**

- 4 players per Singles subevent. Remaining players will be placed in Waiting List
- Host Wildcards are not included on this limit.
- In case the subevent is undersubscribed, more than 4 player per subevent can be accepted.

**Changes in Nominations**

- Only changes in doubles and mixed doubles are allowed. In case of Doubles composed by players from 2 Member Associations, changes are subject to the agreement of both MAs.

**In case of entries above the limit (30 players per singles competition), players will be accepted based on the ITTF Table Tennis Youth Ranking (Week 19 – 4 MAY 2026). Strongly recommend to not book flight tickets before entry deadline! In case of cancellations, only players already in WL are entitled to replace cancelled players.**

**The cancellation of confirmed players after the entry deadline, as well as walk-overs during the event, have a zero-point penalty as a consequence, unless for justified injury or illness with provided proof.**
